**Memorandum of Understanding
Between
Maharaja Institute of Technology Mysore
And
EDspire Research Centre, Mysuru**

This memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into this day, the 30th of October, 2025 by and between Maharaja Institute of Technology Mysore (hereinafter referred as "MIT Mysore" and EDspire Research Centre, Mysuru (hereinafter referred as "EDspire"). The term "MIT Mysore" and "EDspire" are individually referred to as such or a "Party" and collectively referred to as the "Parties".

MIT Mysore and **EDspire** agree that cooperation in Academic and Industry Interaction, Skill Enhancement Program, Certification Training, Internship and Student projects in the areas of immersive technologies including Virtual Reality, Augmented Reality, Robotics, IoT and AI. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

1. Skill Enhancement Programs
2. Certification training
3. Internships and student projects
4. Seminar and workshops
5. Faculty Development Program
6. Establishment of a Centre of Excellence

WHEREAS MIT Mysore is a leading education institution in the field of technical Education. AND WHEREAS EDspire is into business of providing high quality research projects, practical upskilling and training, internships and other allied educational services. AND WHEREAS EDspire is desirous of collaborating with MIT Mysore in conducting skill enhancement programs, certification training, seminars, workshops for the students of MIT Mysore which shall be subject to the availability of vacancies. AND WHEREAS MIT Mysore has agreed for such collaboration.



AND NOW THEREFORE, **EDSpire** and **MIT Mysore** in consideration of the mutual representations, warranties and agreements contained herein, and subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this MoU, and intending to be legally bound hereby agree as follows:

1. DURATION

This MoU shall be valid for a term of Three (3) years from the effective date and shall be renewed for such further period as may be decided mutually by both the parties.

2. OBJECTIVES

MIT Mysore and EDspire have entered this MOU to co-operate and collaborate between themselves to promote more effective use of each of their resources and provide each of them with enhanced opportunities.

1. To conduct skill enhancement programs
2. To conduct certification training
3. To provide internship opportunities and projects for deserving students
4. To conduct seminars and workshops as per availability
5. To conduct Faculty Development Programs
6. To establish Centres of Excellence

3. COMMERCIALS

This MoU shall not give rise to any financial obligation by one Party to another Party. The commercials will be discussed and finalized separately and would be documented through raising necessary PO and Invoice on the other party.

4. Deliverables from EDSpire

EDspire is a leading educational technology research organization, focused on digital pedagogy, human-computer interaction, skilling, and the future of learning with a mission is to revolutionize education by leveraging cutting-edge technologies like VR, AR, Robotics, IoT & AI, and gamification to create immersive learning experiences. EDspire will encourage and support faculties, provide FDP and workshops on a mutually agreed timeline.

5. Deliverables from MIT Mysore

MIT Mysore will ensure the availability of the following requirements:

- A computer lab in the college with computing facilities, with a capacity of at least 40 seats where students can attend the deliverables/sessions with permission from the college authorities.
- The venue must be available to use for the time slot communicated and agreed by both parties.
- The institute has to ensure availability of the following organizational requirements in their college.
 1. One faculty in charge
 2. Wif-fi facility during the sessions
 3. Computers with pre-installed tools and software as requested by EDspire.

6. REVISION, VARIATION AND AMENDMENT

Either Party may request in writing a revision, variation, or amendment of this MOU. Any such revision, variation or amendment agreed to by the Parties shall be in writing and shall form part of this MOU and shall come into force on such date as may be determined by the Parties.

A handwritten signature in blue ink, likely belonging to a representative of MIT Mysore.



7. CO-ORDINATION

Both the parties shall appoint one person as one point of contact/Co-ordinator for the smooth execution of the MoU.

8. CONFIDENTIALITY

Both the parties may receive information proprietary to the other party (the "Confidential Information") in the course of performance of their obligations under this MoU. Confidential Information is not meant to include any information which (a) is publicly available (b) is rightfully received by the parties from third parties without accompanying secrecy obligations (c) is already in either party's possession and was lawfully received from sources other than the parties or (d) is independently developed by the parties. The two parties understand and acknowledge that the Confidential Information is valuable and confidential and agree that it will at all times be kept in trust, to be disclosed only to such persons on a "need to know" basis and that it will be used by the parties for the benefit of others.

Both the parties understand and agree that all written or other tangible data and documentation developed or procured by the other party in performing its obligations under this MoU, whether in printed or electronic form, belongs to the other party and that the other party will have all rights, title and interests therein.

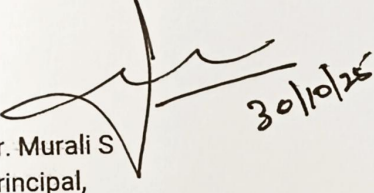
9 GOVERNING LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

This MoU shall be governed by Indian laws and shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Mysuru. Any dispute or difference shall be first discussed between the Parties and resolved. If the dispute or difference is not resolved, the Parties shall refer the same to a sole arbitrator appointed by the Parties. The arbitration proceedings shall be in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and the seat of arbitration shall be Mysuru.

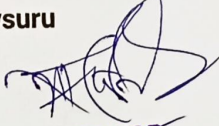


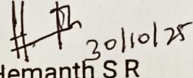

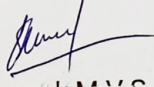
